Order the 2008 Life & Health Valuation Law Manual

*The manual is a reference tool designed to help appointed actuaries comply with the requirements of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) model Standard Valuation Law and the Model Actuarial Opinion and Memorandum Regulation.**

The manual includes a summary of the valuation laws of all fifty states, Washington, DC, and Puerto Rico; copies of the NAIC's model laws and regulations that may have an effect on reserve calculations; a discussion of generally distributed interpretations; and copies of the current actuarial guidelines from the NAIC Examiners Handbook.

As the following list shows, the manual is published in a variety of media so Academy members can choose the version that best meets their individual needs. The prices listed on the order form are for Academy members only, and they reflect a 50 percent discount from the regular prices. Options available include the following:

Single-user web access gives one person unlimited online access to the 2008 Life & Health Valuation Law Manual until December 31, 2008. The subscriber receives a user name and password to access the manual online. Subscriber is prohibited from sharing the username and password with any other persons.

Multiple-user web access permits a company and its affiliates to give employees unlimited web access to the 2008 Life & Health Valuation Law Manual until December 31, 2008. The subscriber receives one user name and one password that can be distributed to employees who want access to the manual online.

The single-user CD-ROM subscription permits one person to use and install a CD-ROM copy of the 2008 Life & Health Valuation Law Manual on a primary (workplace) and secondary (home or laptop) computer. It prohibits using or installing the CD-ROM on any other computer.

The multiple-user CD-ROM subscription permits a company and its affiliates to make copies of the CD-ROM version of the 2008 Life & Health Valuation Law Manual and distribute them to employees. The CD-ROM is programmed in a multi-platform format.
