Order the 2011 Property/Casualty Loss Reserve Law Manual

The manual is a reference tool designed to help appointed actuaries comply with the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) Annual Statement requirements for a statement of actuarial opinion.*

The manual includes a summary of the text of the NAIC Annual Statement of Instruction for the Statement of Actuarial Opinion for property/casualty, title loss, and loss expense reserve, as well as a summary of other pertinent annual statement instructions. In addition, for each state, the manual includes a summary of the statement of actuarial opinion requirements and the text of the statutes and regulations establishing those requirements.

As the following list shows, the manual is published in a variety of media so Academy members can choose the version that best meets their individual needs. The prices listed on the order form are for Academy members only, and they reflect a 50 percent discount from the regular prices. Options available include the following:

- Single-user web access gives one person unlimited online access to the 2011 Property/Casualty Loss Reserve Law Manual until December 31, 2012. The subscriber receives a user name and password to access the manual online. The subscriber is prohibited from sharing the username and password with any other persons.
- ➤ Per-jurisdiction web access gives one subscriber unlimited online access to the subscriber's selected jurisdictions of the 2011 Property/Casualty Loss Reserve Law Manual until December 31, 2012. The subscriber receives a user name and password to access the manual online. The subscriber is prohibited from sharing the username and password with any other persons.

- Multiple-user web access permits a company and its affiliates to give employees unlimited web access to the 2011 Property/Casualty Loss Reserve Law Manual until December 31, 2012. The subscriber receives one user name and one password that can be distributed to employees who want access to the manual online.
- The single-user CD-ROM subscription permits one person to use and install a CD-ROM copy of the 2011 Property/Casualty Loss Reserve Law Manual on a primary (workplace) and secondary (home or laptop) computer. It prohibits using or installing the CD-ROM on any other computer.
